Feb. 20th Council Meeting Highlights: Rev. Scott chaired the meeting. CORRESPONDENCE: Membership transfer request received from Stephen Stuart, Motion Carried, REVIEW OF FINANCIAL **REPORT:** Joe shared a preliminary draft of the 2024 Budget. He explained that we are in a similar boat financially as previous years. In 2023 we were fortunate to have the grants cover most costs. Expenses are generally fixed so it is hard to find money within what we currently have. We need to find ways of generating more revenue. Less money was spent on tech than anticipated in 2023. Declining membership is a concern. COMMUINCATIONS COMMITTEE: Two quotes received for the website but no decision has been made yet. VISIONING: Increased use of the building: Kindred works idea will not work for Mount Royal due to a number of factors but the meeting with Kindred Works representative was well presented and the employee volunteered to continue consulting with the church at no current cost. She offered ideas to increase building use. Ex: better signage for what is going on in the church, better use of the space we have and better marketing of it, clearing out the clutter. Accessibility: Major accessibility improvements are highly unlikely without grants. Partnerships: it's been valuable meeting regularly with other local United Churches. Simplified Governance: other forms of governance will be explored. Reducing Carbon Emissions: longer-term goal is to stop using propane entirely. OTHER BUSINESS: Self Assessment: feedback requested from council on the process of the regional self assessment.
