Council Highlights from June 20<sup>th</sup> Meeting: Council met to discuss the results of the visioning activity that was led by Rev. Kendall Harrison on May 6<sup>th</sup>. Council had lively discussion about next steps. The value of focusing and prioritizing on both short term and long term goals was stated. Council will continue to look at options for increased rental use of the building and look into organizations that could assist with larger building use projects.
