Will you follow in the way of Jesus Christ, resisting oppression and evil, seeking justice, and witnessing to God's love for all creation? If so answer, **I will God being my helper.**

Will you share your faith with Sadie, growing with her in faith, hope and love?

If so answer, I will God being my helper.

Will you encourage Sadie to seek confirmation, so that being strengthened in faith by the Holy Spirit and nurtured at the Table of our friend Jesus; she may go on to serve God faithfully throughout her life?

If so answer, I will, God being my helper.
