#### **COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS:**

**CORRESPONDENCE:** Thank you notes were received from AST, St George's Anglican Church and the Peter McKee Community Food Centre for our contributions to their programs.

FINANCIAL REPORT: the Finance Report for the 9 months ended September 30, 2021 was presented by the treasurer which shows a current operating deficit of (\$32,812) compared to (\$22,162) last year before the CEWS wage subsidy. Government wage subsidy (CEWS), of \$22,713 has been received during the year to assist with salaries and has reduced the current year deficit to (\$10,099). The CEWS subsidy program, which has helped to offset reduced fund raising over the past year, will end on October 23 unless extended by the Federal government. It is hoped that the current year deficit will be eliminated by December 31 with special givings of Thanksgiving and Christmas, the grocery card fund raising as well as regular envelope givings.

**PROPERTY MAINTENANCE:** the boiler was turned on as temperatures start to drop. A handicapped sign has been ordered for the main parking lot.

**COMMUNICATION:** services, obituaries and other requests are posted to the FB page. Scott requested to be given permission to post relevant items on FB. Virtual Voices is recorded weekly.

**ADHOC VISIONING COMMITTEE:** the committee meets frequently.

**SYSTEMS COMMITTEE:** the number of home views increased by roughly the same amount as those who would normally attend in person while the sanctuary has been closed to in-person worship.

**MINISTRY AND PERSONNEL:** All staff reviews will be conducted in the coming month.

**WORSHIP COMMITTEE:** October 24 is an infant Baptism, and October 31 is the All Saints Sunday in the form of a Taizé service. Everyone enjoyed seeing the videos of the children on Thanksgiving.

**FUNDRAISING/ TRUSTEES:** insurance costs will increase again this year. The gift card fundraiser has concluded. There was a profit of \$700. Another \$30,000 will be purchased in December.

# **CHRISTIAN DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE:**

recommended that the plan of administration description of Christian development be reviewed and updated to include all ages.

**COVID related discussion:** with baptism and unvaccinated children present the GNB requirements for other than 100% fully vaccinated will be followed for the October 24<sup>th</sup> service.
