Council Highlights: CORRESPONDENCE: "Thank You" card from the Art Club thanking Mount Royal. A thank you letter was received from the Inspiration Café and the Peter McKee food bank for the recent donation. REVIEW OF FINANCIAL REPORT: The 2023 budget will be brought to the January council meeting for review. NOMINATIONS **COMMITTEE:** No chair of this committee. Discussion about what positions are available for 2023. MINISTRY AND PERSONNEL: Job descriptions for Director of Music and Minister were submitted. Remote work in the event of weather closures, illness, etc. was discussed. 2023 Cost of living increases recommended by UCC were approved which are: 1. 3.4% COL salary increase 2. Continuous education and learning resource \$1543 3. Travel: \$0.55 per km 4. Visiting Ministry Personnel = \$232 daily rate. **PASTORAL CARE:** Pastoral Care worked together with UCW to organise another successful year of cookie and holiday card delivery. UCW/CRAFT GROUP: Continue to meet regularly. WORSHIP **COMMITTEE:** Worship committee is looking forward to upcoming Blue Christmas, Christmas eve services and Epiphany Sunday. MINISTERS **REPORT**: Rev Scott Stuart submitted a written report outlining his activities since the last council meeting. Shared how the donation of winter items were extremely well received at Ensemble. FUNDY ST. LAWRENCE DAWNING WATERS REGIONAL COUNCIL: The annual meeting will be held in Charlottetown in 2023. Our region representative and the minister will both attend. PROPERTY MAINTENANCE: The mini split heat pumps were successfully installed, the Mount Royal entrance step has been replaced and options were presented for the lighting project. **COMMUNICATIONS**: Recent communications activity include Facebook posts, Christmas letter, virtual voices and website updates. FUNDRAISING/ TRUSTEES: Sobeys cards are selling well. Potential fundraisers (chilli, auctions, dinners). Sears will no longer be our insurance provider as we are now dealing directly with the Hub Insurance. CHRISTIAN DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE: Kids Korner will resume every other Sunday beginning mid January 2023. **OUTREACH:** White Gift raised close to 2300 dollars. \$1000 of gift cards will be given to Bessborough school, \$500 for Hillcrest School and \$500 for St. Bernadette. The remainder will stay at the church for donations arising through the holiday season. **NEW BUSINESS:** Visioning Committee recommendations: document to prioritize recommendations, set timelines, costs, responsibility etc. was discussed. Living in Transformative Change Zoom Conversation: This January 15, 2023 event was discussed and will be shared early in the new year. **DATE OF** NEXT MEETING: January 13th 2023 at 7:00pm.
