Service of Holy Communion

One: The Lord be with you. **All: And also with you.**One: Lift up your hearts.

My faith family, in and through Christ, these are not the elements of The United Church of Canada, nor do they belong to the Mount Royal Community of Faith; this is the gift of our Lord Jesus Christ and all whose lives are open to him are welcomed at this table.

Concluding Prayer:

One: Now we are one: we are one with each other, one with the church universal, one with Christ and so as one let us pray together our concluding prayer:

All: Lord Jesus Christ, you had once put your life into our hands; now we put our lives into yours. Take us, renew us and remake us. What we have been is past; what we shall be through you, still awaits us, and on this day may the light of Christ dwell within us guiding our way, Amen

Blessing: May God's love and grace shine upon you. May the Light of Jesus shine from within you. May the joy of the Spirit shine all around you. And may you and those you love, wherever

they may be, know the care and comfort of Christ this day, Amen.
