Church Council Highlights: CORRESPONDENCE: We received a request from St Emmanuel Orphanage School in Uganda for donations to their well drilling project. A donation of \$200 will be sent. A reminder to order church offering envelopes was received. It was decided to move to a monthly envelope rather then weekly. UCW/CRAFT GROUP: 11 people attended Craft Group. A wild time was had by all. **FUNDRAISING/TRUSTEES:** Another batch of grocery cards will be purchased in the fall. Hopefully, if Covid numbers remain low, a rummage sale can be planned for the fall as well as a pancake breakfast and perhaps a chili cook-off. An appraisal on the property will be done this summer. It was suggested that early in September a calendar of events be made to ensure all of the suggested events happen without overlapping. CHRISTIAN DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE: Rev Catherine Stuart offered to assist with evaluating the BLAST curriculum. A movie night is planned for July 29 (Julie and Julia). It will be in the church basement. COVID related discussion: It was suggested that we loosen the masking requirements by asking people to wear a mask when they enter the church and allowing them to remove once they are seated. We will ask that they put masks on when singing and if they sit next to someone to be sure and ask if they are

comfortable with them not wearing a mask. OTHER BUSINESS: **BBQ** – there is a neighbourhood welcoming BBQ planned for Sep 18 after church with a rain date of Sep 25. It is intended to be an outdoor activity serving hot dogs, cold drinks and cookies. **Energy** Audit - PMC was engaged to provide an Energy Feasibility Study. They suggested 14 energy conservation measures that we are looking at. The United Church of Canada offers a grant program called Faithful Footprints which offers up to 66% of the cost of approved projects to a maximum of \$20,000 and can only be applied for once. NB Power offers a 25% grant for projects that provide energy conservation. These two programs combined will allow us to undertake the flat roof replacement over the office, replacing the light fixtures in the building with LED lighting, sealing the annular space where the brick wall meets the roof in the sanctuary and installing a mini-split heats pump for the office area and board room. The total cost of these four projects would be \$69,600 with a net cost after grants and reserve funding of \$31,060. **Rental Agreement** – the existing fee structure for our rental agreement has not been updated since 2011 and should be revised. In addition to the amount charged for the minister, organist, soloist and custodian there needs to be a fee structure in place for the tech services of sound, live-streaming and recording of services. There should be a basic amount charged with add-ons for extra services provided. CRA requires everyone (members and non-members) to be charged the same amount and that funds paid to individuals (minister, organist, etc) are supposed to be paid to them through ADP so that any extra earnings will be part of their taxable income. Comparing to other tech providers \$35-75/hour per crew member would be a reasonable rate to charge for tech services. Visioning – some of the Visioning initiatives painting the games on the parking lot, and the fall welcoming BBQ.
