Council Highlights: CORRESPONDENCE: Universal Portrait Studios regarding church photos and a church directory booking in the fall of 2022 FINANCIAL REPORT: treasurer's report to April 30, 2022. The operating revenue for April is up almost \$4,800 over last year and up \$3,400 over prior year-to-date figures. Most of the increase is due to the timing of the Sobeys gift cards. Operating expenses are up \$1,200 from the same month last year and up about \$3,000 over the four-month year-to-date figures. Wages, fuel and audio-visual costs account for most of the differences. This results in an operating surplus for April of \$4,630 and an accumulated surplus of \$1,008 so far this year. A cheque will be sent to Camp Ta-Wa-Si and \$2,000 in Sobeys gift cards be forwarded to the Peter McKee Food Bank. An additional \$1,000 in gift cards from outreach will be forwarded to neighbourhood schools to assist with their breakfast programs. Bessborough will receive \$500, Hillcrest will receive \$250 and École Sainte Bernadette will receive \$250. PROPERTY MAINTENANCE: written report detailing the two guotes received for the replacement of the roof over the church office. The contract will be awarded to Nowlan Roofing who submitted the lowest bid of \$31,830 +HST. **MINISTRY AND PERSONNEL**: Tracy has requested to work half days for June and July. This request was granted. Both Tracy and Scott will be on vacation for the first three weeks of August and France has requested the month of August off for vacation. Debbie and Marlene will both attend M&P training provided by the Region on May 28. A motion was made to **not** have a worship service on August 28th. (In addition to being closed August 7, 14, and 21). PASTORAL CARE: reviewed the directory of persons at Mount Royal to ensure that nobody is being missed. Rev. Stuart will provide a session on Medical Assistance in Dying in September and he will also do a book study called "Forgiving

Yourself" which will be open to members of the greater community of faith. UCW/CRAFT GROUP: UCW are excited about being able to provide the bridge luncheon on Thursday. Craft Group continues to meet every week and hopes to start meeting outside soon. WORSHIP **COMMITTEE**: Graduate Sunday will be June 12th. It will be a lay person-led service. They would like to have a photograph of each grad. It will be a youthful service. June 19th Rev Danny Compton has been asked to provide pulpit supply. FUNDY ST. LAWRENCE DAWNING WATERS REGIONAL COUNCIL: the M&P training will be provided for all 3 regions. The Annual Meeting will be in June with 3 pre-meeting webinars. Marlene sits on the Pastoral Relations committee which has been very busy with appointments being renewed and community of faith profiles being prepared. SYSTEMS COMMITTEE: The numbers of persons viewing the services is remaining steady even as in-person attendance increases. There was discussion about the sound in the sanctuary. FUNDRAISING/TRUSTEES: no in-person fundraisers are currently being planned but will be revisited in the fall. An appraisal will be necessary for insurance purposes. CHRISTIAN DEVELOPMENT **COMMITTEE:** The plant swap is scheduled for May 29. There was discussion about the possibility of a community hotdog bbg in the fall with youth group leaders in attendance to answer questions that newcomers may have about groups for themselves or their children.
