Council Highlights - VISIONING COMMITTEE PRESENTATION:

Committee presented council with a Visioning Report which is the result of 23 meetings. Committee representatives answered questions and council discussed recommendations. Priorities could be making physical changes, environmental changes and how we ask volunteers to participate. Motion made that council commits to serious examination of the visioning report and creates a priority list of actionable items at the December meeting. CORRESPONDENCE: A lovely "Thank You" card from Tracy Parrot for her retirement party and gift. REVIEW OF FINANCIAL REPORT: Treasurer submitted report and reviewed it noting that recent fundraisers (pancake and rummage) have been guite successful. Offerings have not fluctuated much since last year however costs are rising, and major repairs are significant. **PROPERTY** MAINTENANCE: Heat pumps were installed in church office and minister's office on November 17 and 18. PASTORAL CARE: The annual holiday cookie delivery to folks at home this year has been organised. UCW/CRAFT GROUP: UCW gave a \$2000 donation to Mount Royal United Church recently. Craft group will be making a significant donation soon. WORSHIP COMMITTEE: White Gift Sunday is on December 4th. The recipients will be the same schools as last year. MINISTERS REPORT: Rev Scott Stuart submitted a written report to outline his many activities since the last council meeting. **COMMUNICATION:** Postings of interest to the church are being shared on Facebook. Upcoming Christmas letter sent from the office will be printed in colour. CHRISTIAN DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE: Kids Korner is seeing an increase of children and volunteers are very much appreciated. They Continue using Illustrated Ministries program. **OUTREACH:** Summary shared of recent Reconnect meeting. In Oct. Reconnect had 33 new clients who have predominantly been priced out of their living arrangements. The city has seen an influx of individuals from neighbouring provinces with the current homeless population exceeding 500. Many clients are seniors and working poor. Motion to donate \$200 in Sobeys gift cards (that will be used to purchase \$5 Tim cards) to YMCA Reconnect and \$200 in Sobeys gift cards to United Way for Inspiration Café. **NEW BUSINESS:** A motion to move the date of the December meeting to December 13, 2022 was made. The

importance of having an up to date rental agreement was discussed.
